

# AHEAD OF THE RULES

SynthCamp is an indie music marketplace built around honest AI disclosure. Artists declare each release as acoustic, hybrid, or AI-crafted, and the platform shows that as Creative Credits, not a warning label. The same disclosure is sealed into the audio with a cryptographic signature anyone can check.

## THE REGULATORY ANGLE

The EU AI Act's transparency duties for AI-generated content apply on 2 August 2026. Under article 50, the duty to mark that content in a machine-readable form falls on the tools that generate it, not on a marketplace that resells it.

SynthCamp marks and signs anyway, and publishes the signing keys so the claim does not rest on trust. It is built for those rules before they apply.

As a micro-enterprise it also sits below the DSA thresholds that trigger the heaviest transparency duties, and meets the spirit of them regardless. We go beyond what the law asks of a marketplace this size.

## HOW THE DISCLOSURE HOLDS UP

**Disclose.** Artist-declared Creative Credits, acoustic to AI-crafted, plus tags for the specific tools used.

**Sign.** An Ed25519 signature rides inside the audio. The public keys are posted, so a third party can verify it.

**Preserve.** Generator watermarks, from Suno or Udio, survive the encode pipeline intact rather than being stripped.

**Pay.** Pay-what-you-want above an artist floor. You pay the artist directly, 85% of every sale, through Stripe Connect.

Do not take our word for it. Drop any SynthCamp track into the public verifier and confirm the signature in your own browser.
